

## **2009 High School Club League**

Revised February 22, 2009

1. All coaches need to be certified at the appropriate level through the USA hockey coach's certification program.
2. All players, coaches, and managers need to be registered with USA Hockey.
3. All referees will be USA Hockey certified and registered.
4. Game: 3, 15 minute stop periods. If at the end of regulation play the score is tied, there will be 1, 5-minute sudden death overtime period played 4 on 4. Any penalties in existence at the end of regulation will carry over into the overtime.
5. Rules: USA Hockey youth rules and penalty times will be in effect for all games. This will include the NO TOLERANCE provisions for spectators. Modifications: Tag-Up off sides.
6. Player eligibility: Student athletes that will be entering grades 9 through 12. No graduating seniors, Junior A or B players, or higher, from the 2008-2009 season or earlier, are eligible.
7. Team Rosters: There is a maximum of 25 players authorized for the team roster. There is a maximum of 20 players that can dress for any game. Game score sheets are to be completed by the team coaches prior to the start of each game. No players can be added after the start of the game. Players cannot participate on multiple teams. USA Hockey Team Registration will need to be accomplished prior to any team or player being allowed to take the ice. Theresa Jackson, President of the Cicero Youth Hockey Association, is handling registration information and forms.
8. The teams will supply a scorekeeper and time keeper, as well as a penalty box attendant.
